### Transportation from Shanghai to Nanjing:

This trip takes about 90 minutes and costs 230RMB (est. \$33 USD) for a first class seat or 135RMB (est. \$20 USD) for second class seat. Trains depart every 10-20 minutes from 6:00am-9:30pm daily.

**6. Networking/Social Events:**

The evening event on Tuesday, March 28, provides an opportunity for attendees to network and socialize. Enjoy a buffet dinner featuring both local and western food at the ballroom beside the conference ballroom located on the third floor of the Hilton Nanjing Hotel. Following dinner, the activities will continue at Strikers Sports Bar & Grill, located on the first floor of the hotel. Each Plugfest participant will receive a coupon to receive one free bottled drink (juice, beer, or soft drink). Any additional beverages should be paid for separately. ## **7. Testing Rooms and Resources**

Each company will need to reserve one or more rooms for testing.

*IMPORTANT: Testing rooms are separate from accommodation rooms, and are booked in addition to the rooms necessary for attendee accommodations.*

Note: Testing is done by representatives of two companies:

- One having the system level product(s), will have a testing room as their base of operation.
- The other is the 'tester' who moves between testing rooms with their product(s) to be tested in association with the system level products. The tester, does not need a test room, while the company with the system-level product does.

The number of rooms reserved is up to each company and are paid for by the designated company representative upon check-in. The UEFI Forum and company sponsors provide a common meeting room, daily luncheon buffet and light breakfast for local attendees (rooms include breakfast).

The hotel will provide tables and chairs in testing rooms upon request. The hotel will charge a small service fee for this setup. This can be arranged in advance of the event or upon arrival. Once on-site, please provide your test room number with the event registration desk.

## **8. Visa Application and Invitation Letter**

Travel into the PRC often requires a visa. To obtain a China business visa, you will need to go through your local consulate or visa agency. Part of the application paperwork includes an invitation letter from a host company based in the PRC. Byosoft will supply invitation letters to attendees upon request.

Note: Your passport must have at least six (6) months of remaining validity upon the return date from your travel in the PRC.

**9. Additional Information**

Electrical Usage and Conversion

The electricity used in China is 220-volt AC. Wash rooms in many middle and high-class hotels are equipped with transformer plugs for electric shavers and hair dryers. These adapters are not designed for high performance and are not recommended for use with high-power devices. For safety purposes, please bring an adapter rated to the power demand of your product.

Currency Exchange

Usually, four-star and five-star hotels offer exchange service. Mostly people will go to banks as they typically provide better exchange rates. Remember to take your passport, which needs to be presented when converting currency in the country. Be aware that in remote areas, it is difficult to exchange currency or use a credit card, so it is advisable to have enough money when if you are planning to visit a remote area. Please keep all your exchange receipts and note exchange rates to covert RMB to other currencies can be quite unfavorable. It is recommended that you use up your RMB prior to leaving the country.

**UEFI Technology Conference Plugfest Participant Agreement**

This Participant Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into as of the signature date below (the "Effective Date") by and between the UEFI Forum, Inc., 3855 SW 153rd Drive, Beaverton, Oregon 97006 ("UEFI") and You, and all other participating companies who sign a counterpart copy of the Agreement. Throughout this Agreement, "Participant(s)" shall collectively refer to You, and each of the other participating companies in the Event.

**1. The Event.** The UEFI Technology Conference Plugfest ("Event") brings all event participants together at a single location to validate PC system manufacturers, computing platform manufacturers, card manufacturers, and test tool manufacturers. At the Event, various companies, including the undersigned Participant may test interoperability of their products with those of other companies in attendance.

**2. No Endorsement or Guarantee.** Participation in the Event in no way indicates sponsorship, endorsement, or certification of this Event or of any products displayed or tested by any Participant at the Event. You agree to allow UEFI to use your company's name in general press releases about the Event, when listing companies involved, unless UEFI receives a written request, prior to the end of the Event, to exclude you from such press releases.



**3. Confidentiality.** You may elect to conduct testing of Your products with other Participants. You may be exposed to pre-release product information of Participants. You agree to treat the test activities, the test results, and the pre-release product information as confidential information ("Confidential Information") and to refrain from disseminating or disclosing the same to others, except to Your employees having a need to know the Confidential Information, without express written permission of the Participant who disclosed it. Any Participant documentation including Confidential Information distributed at the Event must be clearly marked as such in some manner. Except as expressly provided for herein, the obligation of non-disclosure (i) by You of Confidential Information received by You from another Participant(s) hereunder will terminate five (5) years after receipt of the Confidential Information; and (ii) by a Participant of Your Confidential Information received by such Participant hereunder will terminate five (5) years after receipt of the Confidential Information. **7. No Commitment. No Proprietary Rights once Disclosed.** This Agreement imposes no obligation or commitment on UEFI to take any action upon items expressed at the Plugfest, including, but not limited to, those statements articulated within a roundtable discussion, or like event session, and other Plugfest events in which members from any one or more of the every level of UEFI membership level participate.
